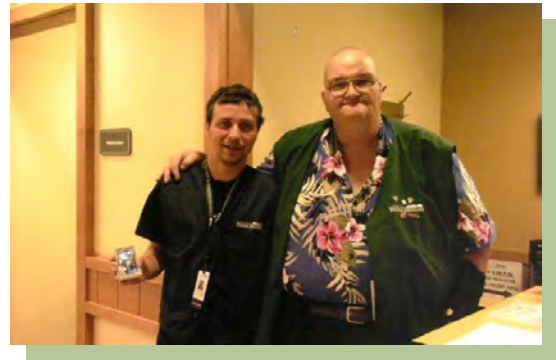


Junior Volunteer Program

- Every summer Littleton Regional Healthcare hosts a *Junior Volunteer Program* for local students between the ages of 14 and 18.
- The program provides an excellent opportunity to gain work-related experience as well as community service hours in your hometown.
- This year the program runs from Tuesday, June 19, 2018 to Friday, August 10, 2018. It is a seven week program and students will be assigned *at least* one 4-hour shift per week.
- To participate students must commit to attending 5 out of the 7 weeks of the program; submit a completed application by Tuesday, June 12, 2018 and attend a 3-hour orientation on Tuesday, June 19, 2018 from 8:30 am - 12:00 pm at Littleton Regional Healthcare.
- The orientation is designed to make students fully acquainted with Littleton Regional Healthcare, our policies, procedures and their assigned position at the hospital.
- Students can be stationed at various locations and in different departments throughout the hospital based on their availability and area(s) of interest.
- Each student will be given a mentor for the duration of the program. This will be a hospital employee and/or adult volunteer.



- At the end of the program students will receive a certificate of completion, a gift as a token of our appreciation, and notification of total community service hours will be sent to their school.
